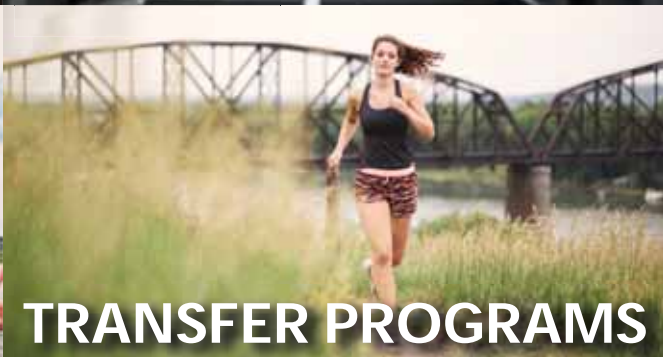

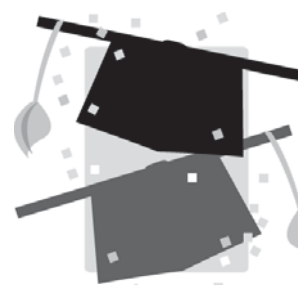
"I have been to speech tournaments in High school and Middle school. I have won awards in impromptu and been all over the state.
