THE OPEN RANGE

By the time the “incident” was over, it was a foregone conclusion as to who was the hero in Israel’s rendition of the story.

Intercepting and either disarming or destroying hundreds of drones which carried ballistic cruise missiles, Israel’s middle-defense systems were the unanimous first choice. This amazing feat deserves an introduction which consists of for one thing, a history lesson.

Back in what my kids call the dark ages before either they or cell phones saw the light of day, some innovative and creative (and influential) people were working on an idea. One eventually became a box office smash and the other ended up in the trash (or nearly did) but emerged in the development of a multi-layered missile defense system used by Israel in the past, but having a full coming out last week. A version of what President Ronald Reagan put forth as a vision for the future (originally dubbed SDI and nick-named Star Wars) kept the nation of Israel safe with a nearly perfect performance when the dust settled.

What is interesting about the story is that one of its most vocal opponents in the early stages stands to gain the most from its success as a political tool. Who would that be? And what advantage would he derive from it? Hear his words of opposition from a speech in 1986 to the National Press Club, “Star Wars

represents a fundamental assault on the concepts of alliance and arms control agreements that have buttressed American security for several decades, and the president’s continual adherence to it, constitutes one of the most reckless and irresponsible acts in the history of modern statecraft.”
