DAKOTA DATEBOOK

July 1, 2024 — On July 1 of 1901, Hazel Josephine Onerheim was born near St. John, North Dakota. The following story is taken from Hazel's personal notes and diaries, which she dutifully kept until her death at age 99.

In her own words, Hazel wrote," About the first I remember is my father sitting in our log cabin, having his leg bandaged. He had cut it while cutting trees in the woods. This was in the Turtle Mountains. Then I remember my sister, Anna, sitting in a chair with a wash dish on another chair. My father was sewing up a gash in her head. My brother, Oswald, had been chopping wood with a double bitted axe with Anna standing behind him. The axe was heavy and as he raised it, it fell back on Anna's head."

Hazel continued her life story by saying," We had a fire in the mountains when I was around two years old. I had wandered away while everyone was busy with other things. It was a warm day and I fell asleep in the road where they found me. I remember laying there, picking up little stones and putting them in a horse's hoof print.'

Hazel's story continued with," We moved to Minneapolis when I was five years old. My father wanted better things for his children. When he had us settled he went to Montana and worked in a saw mill where he earned \$8 a day. We lived in a tenement in Minneapolis. We had six rooms and there were four apartments in the building. I remember an Anderson family lived below us. Frances Anderson was my age and my friend. I went to school there in the first grade.'

The journal continued ... "Our brother and sister, who were twins, were born in Minneapolis and died there. Louis was three days old when he died. We were visiting some friends in Eau Claire, Wisconsin when Lenore became ill and died at age three months.'

"My brother Oliver was 12, brother Oswald was 10, sister Anna was 8, I was six, and my brother Sam was 4 when our father died. My father died in Montana of typhoid fever."

Freight Line Fugitive

July 2, 2024 — Sheriffs Moorhead empty-handed. and deputies from Fargo and Moorhead launched a large-scale manhunt on this date in 1923, after a robbery suspect killed a South Dakota sheriff and escaped near Moorhead. The suspect, Edwin Rust, was wanted on robbery charges in Brown County, South Dakota, and was being transported to Aberdeen by Sheriff Isaac

Captured in East Grand Forks in June, Rust was placed in jail until he could be transferred to Aberdeen. On July 1, Sheriff Fulker arrived to transport the suspect. The two boarded the train, but Rust managed to kill Fulker and jump from the moving train. Sheriff Fulker left behind a wife and several children, and local Cass and Clay County authorities immediately formed a posse to capture the fugitive.

For weeks, Rust managed to elude authorities, despite the offer of a \$500 reward. Then, on July 12, two men reported traveling with Rust on the train from Staples to Detroit, Minnesota – now known as Detroit Lakes.

The Becker County Sheriff contacted Fargo with the news, and a large posse travelled to the small town of Detroit in hopes of catching Rust once and for all. For two weeks, the posse's search proved fruitless. Disheartened. the searchers returned to Fargo-

Two weeks later, Fargo's Sheriff Kraemer received word that Rust had been killed in a shoot-out with St. Paul police. Apparently Rust had made his way to St. Paul and had taken up residence at a rundown guesthouse. He had dyed his blond hair black and had begun mugging locals to pay his way.

He was finally captured by police after he and a female accomplice stole a car. After being handcuffed and placed in the back of the police cruiser, Rust managed to free himself and jump from the car. He escaped down an alley, but was soon tracked by police to his rented room. A short gun fight ensued, and Rust was fatally shot. Only later did investigators realize that the dead criminal was in fact the wanted Edwin Rust; they also discovered that the young man had been on parole from Sacramento's Folsom Prison when he committed his crimes in Aberdeen.




