



\$2M DONATION STILL A MYSTERY TO CENTER'S CITY COUNCIL

The city of Center is still trying to figure out where a large sum of money originated and will look to the North Dakota Department of Treasury to find some answers. In January, the city received \$2.17 million in its direct deposit account, but the city wasn't able to tell where the donation came from. After holding a special meeting Jan. 24, the city decided to put the mystery money in a three month CD account through its bank, at First Security Bank. At the city's March 3 regular council meeting, the topic was discussed again. City Auditor RaShell Simenson informed council she had communication with the Treasury Department and discovered the city can find out where the money came from but, according to North Dakota Century Code 57-39.2 23, it cannot disclose that information to the public.






